Each class will focus on a musical idea, instrument family, musical example, and corresponding movement exercise.

Objectives

By the end of the course, students will:

- Have a better understanding of rhythm, tempo, pitch, dynamics, and different composers.
- Be able to demonstrate musical ideas through movement and song.
- Be able to recognize instrument families such as strings, brass, woodwind, and percussion.

Please note: Musical Fanfare is not a "Parent and Me" class, so parents, siblings, and other family members/guests will not be able to sit in the room during class time.

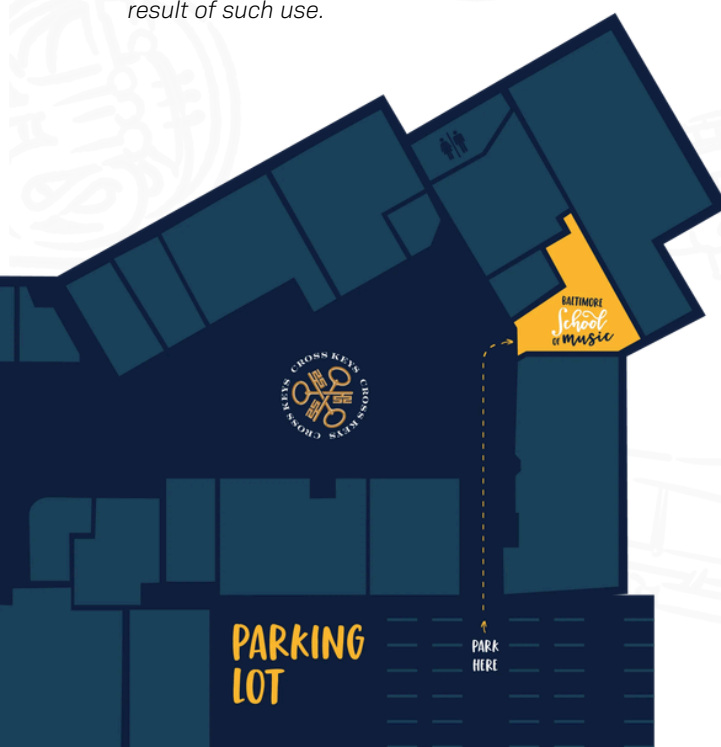

Inclement Weather: If the school closes due to inclement weather, Baltimore School of Music will reschedule the class based on teacher availability.

Substitute/Change of Teacher: Baltimore School of Music reserves the right to provide a substitute teacher and/or permanently change the teacher for any Mini Maestros class if their regular teacher becomes unavailable.
